CORONAVIRUS

Coronavirus, first described in the 1960's, is a large family of viruses that can cause illnesses ranging from the common cold to SARS (Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome), MERS (Middle East Respiratory Syndrome), & now the 2019n-CoV (n=novel/new; 2019=year of discovery; CoV=coronavirus). Coronaviruses are zoonotic, meaning the virus can pass from animals to humans. The virus can also pass from human to human. Coronaviruses get their name because a halo (corona) surrounds the virus.

The 2019nCoV has an incubation period from 1-12 days, with a median incubation period of 5-6 days. This means that someone infected with the virus could be contagious for up to 12 days before symptoms appear. Symptoms include fever, cough, & shortness of breath.

One of the complications of this virus has been "double" pneumonia, or pneumonia in both lungs.

As with a host of other viral diseases, there is no current vaccine to prevent the 2019nCoV. There is



also no specific antiviral treatment for it.

Treatment at this time is geared toward relief of symptoms.

In the case of the 2019nCoV the best offense is a good defense:

- · Avoid people who are ill
- Stay home if you are sick
- Do not touch your face with unwashed hands
- Cough/sneeze into the crook of your elbow
- Wash or sanitize your hands immediately after coughing or sneezing into them
- Wash or sanitize your hands immediately after blowing your nose

Thoroughly cook all meats & eggs
